The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Casino Train Station

The construction tender has been awarded and construction is soon to start on the accessibility upgrade at Casino Station.

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Casino Station as part of the Transport Access Program. The project is expected to take about six months to complete, weather permitting.

The community was invited to comment on the <u>project's concept design (PDF, 501.04 KB)</u>, with all responses helping Transport to understand what is important to customers and the community.

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure across the state


The Casino Station Upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, and parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Key benefits

The project will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Key benefits

- upgrades to existing paths and ramps around the station precinct
- upgrades to the existing accessible car spaces
- a new accessible kiss and ride zone at the front of the station
- modifications to the waiting room and ticket counter
- improved amenities including ambulant toilets
- regrading sections of the platform and installing new tactile indicators
- · improvements to lighting and wayfinding.
