Pymble Station Upgrade

The Pymble Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams, and customers with luggage. We thank you for your patience during this important work.

What's next at Pymble in October?

Throughout October, work will include:

- fit-out of new lifts
- installing electrical services
- upgrading the Pacific Highway footpath
- cable pulling within the rail corridor.

Upcoming work in October

Work will continue **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm**, and from **8am until 1pm on Saturdays**. We will be working outside of standard construction hours over the following periods:

- **From 6am Saturday 1 October to 11pm Sunday 2 October**, we will be working in the Pacific Highway car park and the southbound kerbside lane of the Pacific Highway to carry out kerb and guttering works.
- **From 6am Saturday 8 October to 11pm Sunday 9 October**, we will be working on Grandview Street and around the station precinct to install the structural steel for the new lifts and new power poles.
- **From 6am Saturday 15 October to 11pm Sunday 16 October**, we will be working in the Pacific Highway car park to install the new electrical padmount.
- **From 6am Saturday 22 October to 11pm Sunday 23 October**, we will be resurfacing the Pacific Highway car park.

Road closure Grandview Street

Grandview Street, between Alma Street and Station Street, will be closed **from 12am Saturday 8 October to 11pm Sunday 9 October** to allow for a crane to be set up on the road.

A detour around our work area will be in place via Station Street, Alma Street and Grandview Street.

Pacific Highway footpath and traffic lane closure

The footpath on the Pacific Highway between Grandview Street and the station entrance will be closed **from 4am Saturday 8 October to 11pm Sunday 9 October** to allow for the footpath upgrades to be carried out.

The Pacific Highway kerbside southbound lane will be closed **from 4am Saturday 8 October to 10pm Sunday 9 October** and **from 4am Saturday 22 October to 10pm Sunday 23 October**, to allow for plant and machinery to enter and exit the car park.

Pacific Highway temporary carpark closure

The Pacific Highway carpark will be closed **from 4am to 11pm** on the following dates:

- **Saturday 1 and Sunday 2 October**
- **Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 October**
- **Saturday 15 and Sunday 16 October**
- **Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 October.**

An awning will be delivered to Grandview Street on **Thursday 29 September between 11pm and 5am**.

How this work may affect you

We will be using a range of equipment including excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, concrete trucks and pumps, elevated working platforms, jackhammers, grinders, cranes, and various hand and power tools.

Our work will be noisy at times. Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with these works, including turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Changes to scheduled work

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be

significant changes to the construction program.
