

Redfern Station Upgrade

New Southern Concourse



What happened in January?

In January, we installed lift shafts, stairs, and the rail overpass bridge.

We thank the community for their patience and understanding while we carried out this important work.

What is planned next?

During February we will carry out the following activities:

- continue work on the new station entrance and shared zone on Little Eveleigh Street.
- start work on the new station entrance and new shared zone on Marian Street.
- continue work at the Marian Street and North Eveleigh compound areas, and on the new southern concourse.

When will construction occur?

Our standard construction hours are between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 6pm on Saturdays.

Due to unforeseen weather events, some construction activities may run slightly past 6pm, but these activities are not expected to be noisy. Work is dependent on weather and site conditions and are subject to change.

Are there activities planned out of standard hours?

Some out of hours work is planned to install various bridge components including bridge roofing, lifts, stairs, and stair and platform canopies. Electrical work and delivery of plant and equipment will also take place during a scheduled trackwork period when no trains are running. This enables the construction team to complete essential activities inside the rail corridor safely. These activities will occur on the following dates:

- **2am, Saturday 19 February to 2am, Monday 21 February**

To minimise disruption to customers and community, inaudible out of hours work will take place at the Marian Street compound and behind Platform 1 to pre-assemble lift components on the following dates:

- **From 2am, Saturday 19 February to 12am, Monday 28 February**

In addition to this, out of hours work activities are required for material and equipment removal, deliveries, concrete pouring, pre-assembly of lift components and electrical work. These works are not expected to be noisy and will occur up to two nights per week.

Where will work take place?

The project and work area includes inside the rail corridor, and at site compounds at North Eveleigh and Marian Street. The site access points are at Newtown, Eveleigh, and Erskineville.

Station area and platforms update

Reinstatement of the heritage building will continue and work such as rock breaking, excavation work, concreting, drilling, and material removal will be carried out on and behind Platform 1. Work will continue on the foundations, and fit out of the lift shafts, stairs, and the bridge. General electrical work will also take place within the station area.

Little Eveleigh Street update

Work will continue for the new shared zone on Little Eveleigh Street.

This includes excavation work, tree removal and tree root investigation, exploration of underground services, service installation, backfilling and pavement installation.

Scaffolding will also be in place outside 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street, for removal of materials. Piling work will also occur inside the building.

Traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians during construction.

Marian Street update

Work activities in the Marian Street compound include assembly of lift shafts and other bridge components, construction of the structure of the electrical building and connection of services.

From Monday 21 February, work on the new shared zone will start on Marian Street. Work activities include moving the existing hoarding to take up a portion of Marian Street, excavation work, exploration of underground services and backfilling.

Signage, barriers and traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct vehicles and cyclists during construction.

Other upcoming changes to parking

From Friday 18 February, all car spaces on Marian Street will be permanently removed to enable safe construction and operation of the new shared zone.

In addition to this, parking will be temporarily removed on surrounding streets to enable delivery of plant and equipment to the site compounds:

- Up to 20 parking spaces on Rosehill Street from Friday 18 February to Wednesday 23 February
- Up to 6 parking spaces on Wilson Street from Monday 21 February to Thursday 24 February.

These dates are subject to change, traffic control and signage will be present to reflect any changes and ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

What you may notice

Equipment to be used during these activities may include cranes, vacuum trucks, elevated work platforms, access equipment, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, core hole drills, compactors, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

At times, our activities require the use of equipment that operates at a higher sound level than standard equipment. This includes power saws, grinders, jackhammers, rollers, rattle guns, vacuum trucks, rock hammers or breakers and piling rigs. The use of some equipment can also cause vibration and may be noticeable to nearby residents.

We will minimise noise and vibration impacts by turning off equipment when not in use, and using noise absorbing blankets where possible. A real-time environmental management system is also in place to ensure noise, vibration, and dust levels are operating within our project requirements.
