What happened in May and what is planned next?

During May, work continued on the bridge, including the installation of roof panels across and another set of stairs. On Little Eveleigh Street, we concreted the first stage of the new shared zone, and continued work on the shared zone in Marian Street.

Throughout June, work activities will continue on the New Southern Concourse, and new station entrances and shared zones in Little Eveleigh and Marian Streets.

Our standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm Saturday. Due to unforeseen events such as weather, some construction activities may run slightly past 6pm, however these activities are not expected to be noisy.

Are there activities planned outside of standard construction hours?

Electrical work, delivery of plant and equipment, installation and pre-assembly of bridge components including steelwork, stairs, lifts, canopies, roof panels and screens, and platform resurfacing will occur during the following times.

- **2am Saturday 4 June to 2am Monday 6 June**
- **10pm Friday 10 June to 2am Tuesday 14 June**

- **2am Saturday 25 June to 2am Monday 27 June**

Service investigation, excavation and stormwater installation will also occur intermittently at the corner of Little Eveleigh Street and Lawson Street on the following dates.

- **8am Saturday 18 June to 6am Monday 20 June**
- **8am Saturday 25 June to 6am Monday 27 June**

A single lane closure on Lawson Street will be in place during these times. Traffic control, detour and information signage will be in place to safely direct and assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians. Please refer to the map on the last page for more information.

Minor traffic delays may be experienced during the stop and slow traffic arrangement. If there are weather impacts, the work activities will occur during another weekend, but we will keep the community updated.

Material and equipment removal, deliveries, concrete pouring, pre-assembly of lift components and electrical work may also occur up to two nights per week. These work activities are not expected to be noisy.

Why are there activities planned outside of standard construction hours?

Night work is required to be undertaken outside standard construction hours to ensure the safety of

workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic.

Sometimes out of hours work can be noisy. A noise assessment will be undertaken prior to the work, and more information will be provided to impacted residents closer to date.

Station area and platforms update

During June, work will continue at and around the station area and on platforms. This includes:

- Fit out of the lift shafts, stairs, and bridge
- Electrical work including service installation
- Various concreting work
- Installation of steel parts across the bridge and platforms
- Roofing work across the bridge and platform canopies
- Installation of cable casings across platforms and platform canopies, and on the existing Northern Concourse.

Work will also continue behind Platform 1 including rock breaking, excavation, concreting, drilling, material removal, and the installation of canopy parts, stairs and a lift shaft.

Little Eveleigh Street update

From **Wednesday 1 June to Thursday 30 June**, work activities will occur on Little Eveleigh Street. These activities will occur during standard construction hours and include:

- Underground services exploration
- Roadway and footpath excavation
- Backfilling and concreting
- Service and stormwater installation
- Kerbing, drain, bollard, landscaping and pavement installation
- Tree and tree roots investigation
- Tree and tree stump removal.

Some finishing work in the stage one construction area, between Lawson Street and 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street will be carried out in June. We would like to thank the community for their patience and support throughout stage one.

Work activities on the building at 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street will continue, including the removal of materials, external scaffolding installation, concreting, piling, hammering and service installation. A crane will operate behind Platform 1 to remove and deliver material and equipment into the building.

Service investigation, excavation and stormwater installation will take place within the Wilson Street reserve. The work will be completed in stages to ensure pedestrian and vehicle access is maintained throughout the work activities.

Marian Street update

Work in the Marian Street compound includes the assembly of lift shafts and other bridge components, fit out, tiling and painting of the electrical building, and service connections. The canopy for the new station entrance and associated steel parts will also be installed within the Marian Street compound area. Cranes will operate within the compound to assist with lifting of bridge parts.

From Wednesday 1 June to Thursday 30 June, the work area for the new shared zone on Marian Street will be temporarily extended to include the corner of Marian and Cornwallis Street. Work activities will continue within standard construction hours and include:

- Excavation and rock breaking
- Backfilling and concreting
- Service stormwater and drainage installation
- Pavement installation
- Underground services exploration

During this time, the temporary road closure on Rosehill and Marian Street, and the detour via Margaret Street will remain in place. There may be temporary access changes for residents while this work occurs, but we will keep the community updated. Traffic control will be in place to manage any access changes for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Please refer to the map overleaf for more information.

Work will be undertaken with Sydney Water to modify a water connection on Marian Street. This may require a temporary loss of water to some properties. Sydney Water will directly notify any impacted properties with further information once details are confirmed.

Where will work take place?

Project and work areas include inside the rail corridor, at our site compounds at North Eveleigh and Marian Street, and on Little Eveleigh, Lawson,

Wilson, and Marian Streets. The site access points are at Newtown, Macdonaldtown, Eveleigh, and Erskineville.

Upcoming changes to parking

Parking will be temporarily removed on surrounding streets for service searching and delivery of plant and equipment to our site compounds.

- **Up to 20 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Rosehill Street from Wednesday 1 June to Thursday 30 June**
- **Up to 10 additional parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Rosehill Street from Wednesday 1 June to Friday 17 June**
- **Up to six parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Wilson Street from Wednesday 8 June to Monday 27 June.**

What you may notice

Equipment used during all of the activities outlined in this notification may include cranes, elevated work platforms, access equipment, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, core hole drills, compactors, forklifts, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, watercart, chainsaws, lighting towers, generators, tree stump grinders, mulchers, work vehicles and hand held power tools.

At times, our activities require the use of equipment that operates at a higher sound level than standard equipment.

These include power saws, grinders, jackhammers, rollers, rattle guns, vacuum trucks, rock hammers or breakers and piling rigs. The use of this equipment can cause vibration and may be noticeable to nearby residents.

We will minimise noise and vibration impacts by turning off equipment when not in use and where possible, use noise absorbing blankets.

A real time environmental management system is in place to ensure noise, vibration and dust levels are operating within our project requirements.

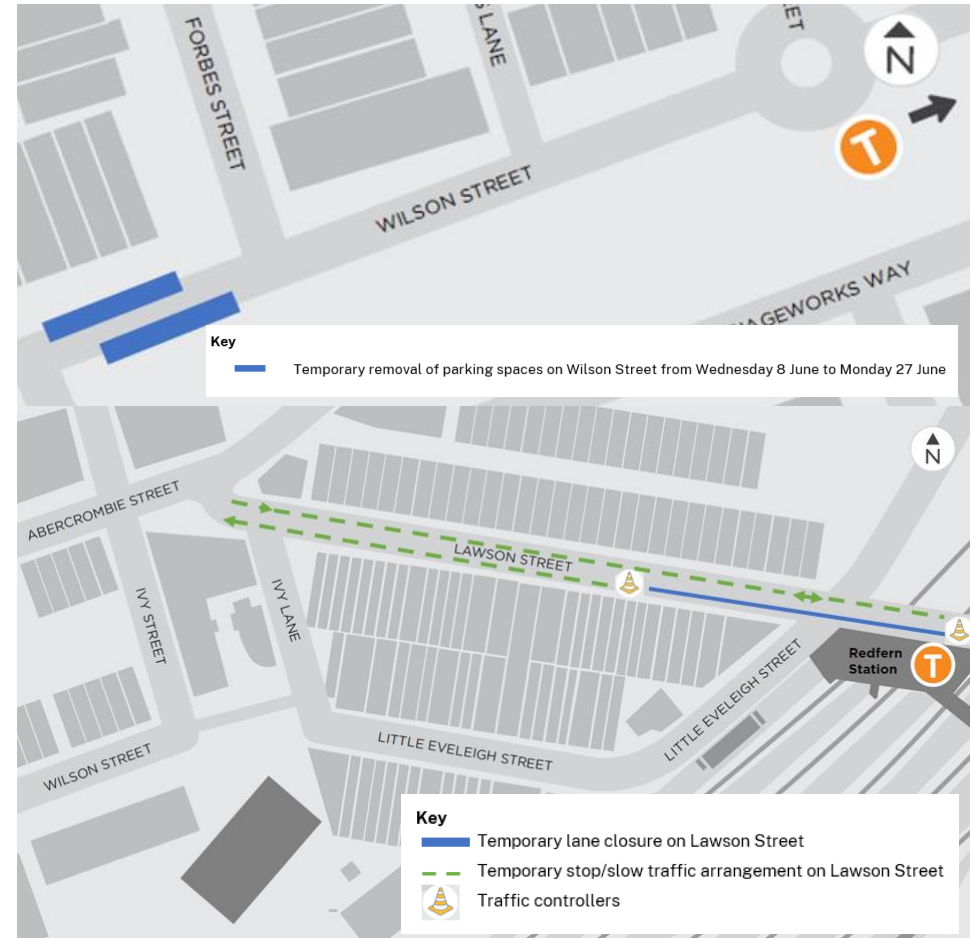
