AC Feeder Upgrade Project – Revesby and Bankstown

Project Update - December 2022

The AC Feeder Upgrade Project is part of the Power Supply Upgrade which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and the new fleet of air-conditioned trains. The work involves upgrades to substations, section huts, overhead wiring, and feeders as well as the construction of new infrastructure across the network.

Upcoming work

During December 2022 the AC Feeder Upgrade Project team will be carrying out work to prepare for a shutdown period.

From Thursday 1 December 2022 to Wednesday 21 December 2022 work will include:

- Testing and Commissioning activities at the Yagoona and Revesby substations
- Packing up work areas prior to the Christmas/New year shutdown period, including removal of plant and materials and temporary filling of pre-drilled holes to make the areas level before the removal of fencing and barriers.

Work will be carried out at Polo Street, Bransgrove Road, Albert Street and Milperra Road, Revesby and Mons Street, Eldridge Road and Northam Avenue, Bankstown.

These works will only be carried out during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**. However, on **Saturday 3 December 2022** work may continue until **6pm** for that day only. These works are subject to site and weather conditions. You will be notified if any of the activities are conducted outside of these times.

Holiday shutdown

Work on the AC Feeder Upgrade Project will pause temporarily from **Thursday 22 December 2022.** We will let you know when we are able to start works again in 2023. Thank you for your patience during the year while we carried out this important work.
