# Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL)

Investigation work continuing along the Kingsway, Caringbah from Tuesday 30 August 2022.

Transport for NSW will be conducting additional investigation work along the Kingsway from Taren Point Road to the intersection of Willarong Road, Caringbah. This work will complete the surveying needed for the final design planning.

Work will include:

- Drilling small holes
- Cutting concrete to conduct underground surveying
- Locating utilities through electronic scanning



## Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to 8 nights shifts from Tuesday 30 August to Wednesday 14 September 2022, weather permitting.

Our night work hours will be from 8pm to 5am starting on the night of Tuesday 30 August. We will not work on Sundays.

## How will this affect you?

This work may be noisy, however we will do what we can to minimise the disruption to residents, including switching off equipment when not in use. We will not work more than two nights in the same location, and we will complete the noisier work by 11pm.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
