

Schofields Commuter Car Park

June 2022

Project update

Transport for NSW is delivering approximately 700 additional commuter parking spaces at Schofields to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The car park is expected to be open to commuters in mid-2022.

Upcoming work

In preparation to open to commuters, work at the Schofields Commuter Car Park work site continues throughout June 2022. Our work will include:

- delivering and removing materials using plant and equipment
- adjusting site fencing and amenities
- installing services within the car park
- asphalt surfacing
- kerb, gutter and footpath construction
- line marking, CCTV, lighting and wayfinding installation
- retaining wall construction
- landscape gardening
- installing and testing light poles
- installing car park fencing.

During June, work will be carried out in areas outside of the Schofields Commuter Car Park work site, including:

- delivering and removing materials, plant and equipment
- converting general car parking spaces into accessible parking spaces in the existing Bridge Street car park at Schofields Station
- relocating the pedestrian crossing across Schofields Road, between Railway Terrace and Veron Road
- right turn lane extension on Veron Road, near the intersection of Schofields Road and Veron Road, involving excavator use, concreting, asphaltting and line marking

Our work schedule

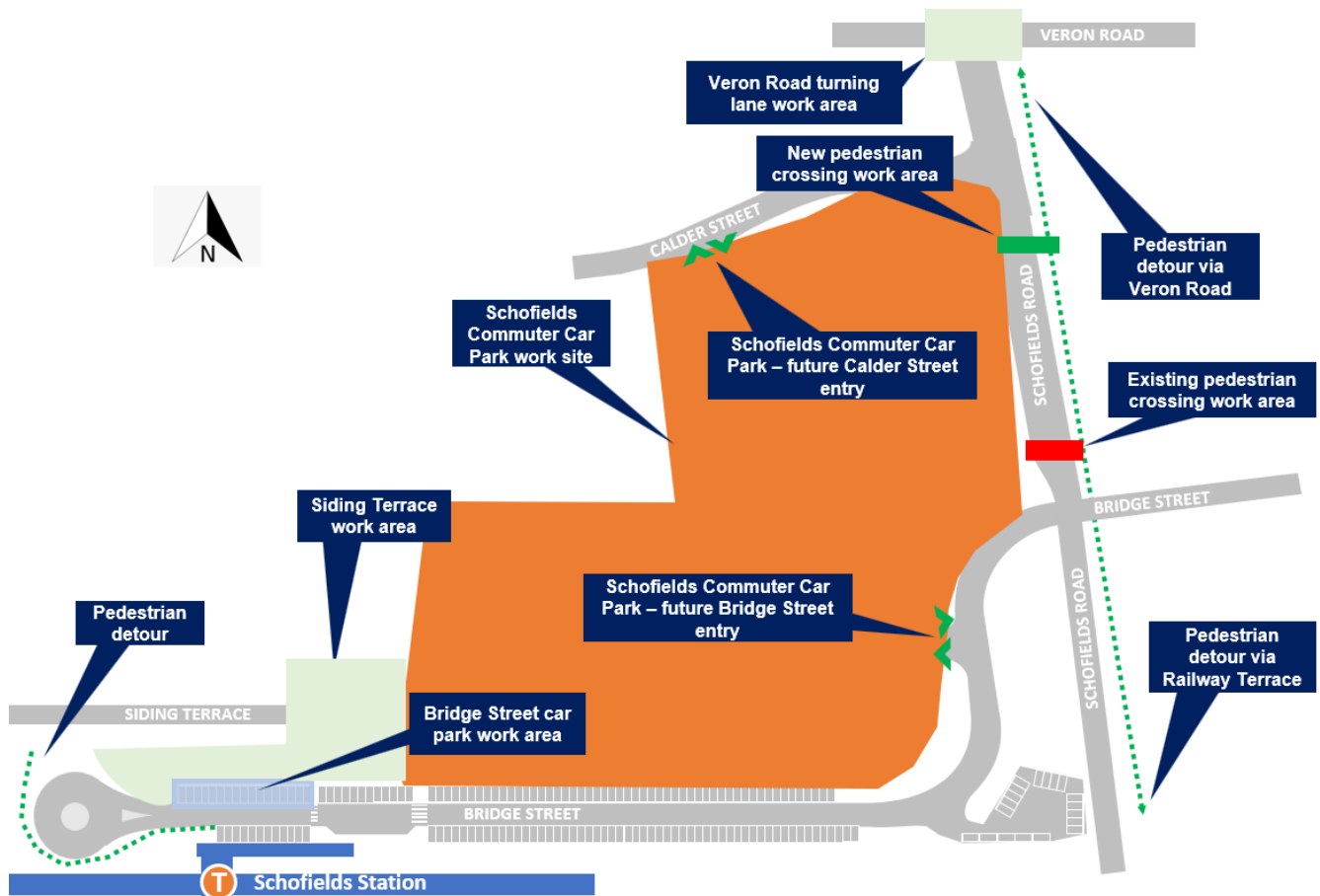
Our work hours will be between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**, weather and site conditions permitting. If any additional work is required outside of these hours, the community will be notified in advance.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers on vehicles used on site. You may notice more construction vehicles and dust. We will be monitoring these activities and where possible, put dust control measures in place.

There will be temporary lane closures and pedestrian detours, however traffic controllers and signs will be in place to maintain two-way traffic and help guide motorists and pedestrians through the area. For your safety, please follow the signs and the directions of traffic controllers.
