

Transport Access Program | August 2022

Stanmore Station Upgrade



The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Stanmore Station customers. The upgraded station will be accessible to all, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents and carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Construction on the Stanmore Station upgrade has commenced with the installation of hoarding in the underpass and on the station platforms and the delivery of materials and equipment.

Upcoming work

From **Monday 1 August to Wednesday 31 August 2022** our work activities will include:

- surveying of platforms, underpass and stairs
- hoarding and signage installation
- piling behind the hoarding on Platforms 1 / 2 for lift installation
- concreting of piles on Platform 1 / 2 from Douglas Street
- temporary removal of five kerbside parking spaces and lane adjustments on Trafalgar Street to enable work on Platform 3
- excavation of an area on Platform 3 to enable electrical work
- partial removal of brick wall on Trafalgar Street to enable piling for lift shaft
- piling between Platform 3 and Trafalgar Street to enable lift installation

Our work schedule

Standard work hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

For the safety of commuters, the community and our workers some work will be conducted outside standard construction hours.

We will advise the community of any work required outside these hours and will keep you informed throughout the construction period.

How will the work affect you?

We understand the work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to minimise noise and lessen disturbance, including:

- turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers
- installing hoarding around work areas in the underpass and on station platforms, ensuring sufficient space remains in these areas for pedestrians and commuters.

During the construction period, to allow for the delivery and removal of material, equipment and machinery and to carry out work on Platform 3:

- there will be temporary partial road and kerbside parking closures on Douglas Street, near the station entrance
- there will be a partial lane adjustment and the temporary removal of five kerbside parking spaces along Trafalgar Street.

For your safety, please follow the direction of signage and traffic control.

Loss of trees and vegetation on the project will be carried out by a qualified arborist and will be offset with new vegetation and trees planted in and around the station precinct.
