

Transport Access Program | October 2022

Stanmore Station Upgrade



The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Stanmore Station customers. The upgraded station will be more accessible, including for people with a disability or limited mobility, parents and carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Construction on the Stanmore Station upgrade will continue through October with tree removal on Platform 3, temporary removal of car spaces and the delivery of materials and equipment.

Upcoming work

From **Saturday 1 October to Monday 31 October 2022** our work activities will include:

- delivering and removal of plant, materials and equipment at the temporary site compounds and the station work areas
- installation of hoarding and fencing on Platform 3
- surveying of land and ongoing monitoring of ground conditions
- service locating and relocating at the station work areas
- lift shaft piling and excavation works on Platforms 1/2 and 3
- demolition of station brick wall on Platform 3 and removal of a tree
- upgrade works to station buildings and amenities
- road and parking changes on Trafalgar and Douglas streets
- truck parking and truck movements on Douglas Street and Trafalgar streets

Our work schedule

Standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

During October, out of hours work will occur. Please see the back page for upcoming out of hours work and the map of works areas.

Kerbside parking changes

To allow for the delivery and removal of material, equipment and machinery and to carry out work on Platform 1/2 and Platform 3, the following parking changes will occur:

- continuation of a temporary road closure on **Douglas Street**, near the station entrance, involving the temporary removal of **four kerbside** parking spaces
- from **1 October 2022**, there will be a partial lane adjustment and the temporary removal of **five kerbside** parking spaces along **Trafalgar Street**.

Out of hours work

For the safety of the community and our workers, this work can only be carried out at night during scheduled rail shutdown periods when there are lower levels of pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

- **Thursday 6 October and Friday 7 October** between 8pm and 5am we will remove the large lilli pilli tree and other vegetation on Platform 3
- **From 4am on Saturday 15 October until 11pm on Sunday 16 October**, there will be delivery and removal of materials to work loading areas, site compounds and to the station work areas within the rail corridor on all platforms.

The equipment used will include vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, high rail flatbed trucks, elevated work platforms, wood chippers, chainsaws, leaf blower, hand tools, piling rig, excavators, augers, concrete trucks and concrete pumps. Some of this work may be loud.

Loss of trees and vegetation on the project will be carried out by a qualified arborist and will be offset with new vegetation and trees planted in and around the station precinct.

How will the work affect you?

We understand the work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to minimise noise and lessen any disturbance, including:

- turning off vehicles when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers
- installing safety hoarding around work areas
- monitoring noise levels.
