# Stanmore Station Upgrade



The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Stanmore Station customers. The upgraded station will be more accessible, including for people with a disability or limited mobility, parents and carers with prams and customers with luggage.

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Construction on the Stanmore Station upgrade will continue mid September with the installation of safety hoarding in the underpass, on the station platforms and the delivery of materials and equipment.

### Upcoming work

From **Monday 12 September to Friday 30 September 2022** our work activities will include:

- delivery and removal of plant, materials and equipment at the temporary site compounds and the station work areas
- safety hoarding and fencing installation in the underpass, on Douglas Street and on Platforms 1/2 and 3
- surveying of land and ongoing monitoring of ground conditions
- inspecting and relocating electrical and utility services
- lift shaft piling reinforcement work on Platforms 1/2
- road, parking changes and setting up work loading areas on Trafalgar and Douglas streets
- concrete truck parking and pumping on Douglas Street
- truck parking and truck movements on Douglas Street

### Our work schedule

Standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

During September, out of hours work will occur. Please see the back page for upcoming out of hours work and the map of works areas.

### Kerbside parking changes

During the construction period, to allow for the delivery and removal of material, equipment and machinery and to carry out work on Platform 3, the following parking changes will occur:

- From **26 September 2022**, there will be a temporary partial road closure on Douglas Street, near the station entrance, involving the temporary removal of two kerbside parking spaces
- From **1 October 2022**, there will be a partial lane adjustment and the temporary removal of five kerbside parking spaces along Trafalgar Street.

## Out of hours work

For the safety of the community and our workers, this work can only be carried out at night during scheduled rail shutdown periods when there are lower levels of pedestrian and vehicle traffic. This night work will take place **between 10pm and 7am** from **Monday 19 September 2022 to Thursday 22 September 2022**. This work includes:

- delivery and removal of materials and equipment to the work loading areas and between the site compounds and the station work areas within the rail corridor
- safety hoarding and fencing installation in the underpass, on Douglas Street and on Platforms 1/2 and 3.

The equipment used will include vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, hi rail flatbed trucks, elevated work platforms, wood chippers, chainsaws, leaf blower, hand tools, piling rig, excavators, augers, concrete trucks and concrete pumps.

We understand the work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to minimise noise and lessen any disturbance, including:

- turning off vehicles when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers
- installing safety hoarding around work areas
- monitoring noise levels.
