Stanmore Station Upgrade

Construction update | December 2022 and January 2023



The Stanmore Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents and carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Out of hours work

Some activities are required to be undertaken outside of our standard work hours. These activities have been planned during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekends.

In **December**, we will be working:

- from **2 am Saturday 10 December to 10 pm Sunday 11 December.**

Activities include:

- excavation and drainage work on platform 2
- upgrading the stairs at the base of platforms 1 and 2
- saw cutting, excavation and concreting on the subway and platform 2
- excavation around male toilet and platform 1 and 2
- electrical upgrades within the station building
- delivery and removal of materials to and from the site compound

Schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. **Please register for email updates** so we can keep you updated about our work. Refer to the contact details on the next page.

Work during standard construction hours for December and January

Day work is continuing **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm**, and **on Saturdays from 8am until 1pm.**

This work includes:

- excavation for the installation of lift shafts 1 and 2
- constructing the steel frame and walls of lift shafts 1 and 2
- excavating for the upgrade of the electrical route on platform 1
- these works will involve piling, concreting and steel work

What to expect

Intermittent periods of high noise: the use of delivery trucks, hi rail flatbed trucks, elevated work platforms, hand tools, piling rig, excavators, augers, concrete trucks and concrete pumps. We will do everything to minimise noise and lessen any disturbance, including turning off vehicles when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers, monitoring noise levels, truck parking and truck movements.

Increased truck and vehicle movements as materials and equipment is delivered to and from the work site.

Current temporary parking restrictions: five car spaces at Trafalgar Street and three car spaces at Douglas Street have been temporarily removed to facilitate vehicle access.

For your safety, please follow the direction of traffic control and signage if in place. We thank you for your patience and we apologise for any inconvenience.
