

Voluntary Management Proposal – Tarago Rail Corridor December 2022

What is a Voluntary Management Proposal?

A Voluntary Management Proposal **(VMP)** is a legal agreement between the NSW Environment Protection Authority (**EPA)** and Transport for NSW **(Transport)** to plan for and complete remediation. It outlines the key stages in the remediation process and the proposed timing for each stage. If the VMP is not delivered as planned the EPA may issue management orders or take some form of action.

Why has Transport amended the Voluntary Management Proposal?

Transport has requested an extension of time from the EPA for the Voluntary Management Proposal (VMP) to remediate the Tarago Rail Corridor.

How is the VMP Amended?

VMP's are amended though an application to the EPA. This is often referred to as a Section 44 (or S.44). We have submitted this request to the EPA through an amendment to the VMP under Section 44 of the Contaminated Land Management Act 1997. This Act enables the EPA to respond to contamination that it has reason to believe is significant enough to warrant regulation. S.44 is part of the Act.

The delays will have impact on the milestones in the previously approved VMP and the new timeframe will result in some delays to complete remediation.

Why has Transport requested more time?

Transport has experienced delays in completing Task 4 of the VMP (the preliminaries required to implement remediation, including planning permits and approvals, and procurement).

The cause of delays in reaching this milestone are:

- Delays in the procurement of a contractor to complete the required activities in Task 4
- Delays experienced by the appointed contractor in procuring technical specialists to assist with the completion of the activities in Task 4.

The project schedule has been updated to reflect the delays.

What are the revised timeframes?

The revised timeframes are documented in the table below.

We have completed a detailed review of the activities required to complete the project and determine the impact to the project schedule and amended the timeframes The tables compare the original deadline, the current deadline and the proposed deadlines.
