Thornleigh Station Upgrade

The Thornleigh Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents and carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

What's next at Thornleigh?

Throughout November, our work will include:

- new lift fit outs
- landscaping work on The Esplanade
- ongoing work on the new stairs and ramp within the Benowie Walkway
- site investigations on Railway Parade
- ongoing work on the station platforms

We will be working over one weekend in late November to carry out the regrading and resurfacing of the commuter car park. We will notify you once the dates are confirmed.

Work schedule

Our day work hours remain as **Monday to** Friday from 7am to 6pm, and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be significant changes to our construction schedule.

Parking and traffic impacts

In November, three parking spaces on Railway Parade between Station and Bellevue streets will be temporarily unavailable to facilitate site investigations including surveying. Traffic control will be in place to safely manage the work area.

The existing bus stop on The Esplanade (**Stop ID 212052**) will be relocated 30 metres south to allow for the removal of the existing bus shelter and landscaping and pavement work.

How this work may affect you

Our work throughout November will involve the use of a range of equipment including excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, trucks, tilt trays, concrete trucks and pumps, dump trucks, jackhammers, compactors, grinders, and various hand and power tools.

Our work will be noisy at times. Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise including turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.


