Thornleigh Station Upgrade

Transport for NSW | July 2022

The Thornleigh Station upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

What's happening in July

Our July work will include:

- constructing new lifts and canopies on the station platforms
- landscaping on The Esplanade and Benowie Walkway
- upgrading the station toilets to a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet
- finishing work on the station waiting rooms
- relocating the vending machines and opal top up machine to the station waiting rooms
- continuation of scaffolding work around the lifts
- Painting along the platform edge and installing tactiles
- extension of the existing footbridge connecting to the Benowie Walkway
- installing metal safety screens along the Benowie Walkway.

Our work schedule

Our standard construction hours remain as **Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm** and on **Saturdays from 8am to 1pm**.

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

Notifications will be provided should there be significant changes to the construction program.

Upcoming weekend work

We have scheduled out-of-hours work **from 6am on Saturday 23 July to 10pm on Sunday 24 July**. This work will take place while trains are not running during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork. Work will include:

- platform regrading and resurfacing
- electrical services upgrades
- removing platform timber hoarding
- platform building refurbishment work

During the weekend work, **six car parking spaces** on Railway Parade will be temporarily unavailable between the station entrance and Bellevue Street.

Benowie Walkway closure extension

Please be advised the Benowie Walkway will need to remain closed until late September 2022. Unfortunately wet weather events, limited power outage permits and scheduling changes has had an impact on our works and the reopening of the walkway. We apologise for this inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

Temporary closure of toilets

The station toilets remain closed until October 2022, to allow for a conversion to a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet.

Temporary toilets are available for station customers in the commuter car park near the accessibility car parking spaces.



Landscaping on the Esplanade

While we carry out landscaping on The Esplanade, a temporary ramp and footpath from the car park will be installed. Due to this work, **one accessible car space** in the commuter car park will be unavailable until October. The station entrance will remain open during this work.

How this work may affect you

Our work will use a range of equipment, including excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, tipper trucks, flatbed trucks, tilt trays, concrete trucks and pumps, elevated working platforms, lighting towers, dump trucks, augers, grinders, chain saws, chippers, and various hand and power tools.

Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with this work, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, turning off equipment when not in use,

placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
