

# Transport Access Program Towradgi Station Upgrade

Community notification November 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Towradgi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.



*Landscaping has been completed on Weber Crescent using a selection of species commonly found in the area.*

## Completed work

Despite unfavourable weather, the site progressed well in October and is close to completion. The site compound was moved further south within the rail corridor to allow landscaping and footpath work to continue. Other work completed in October included the installation of architectural handrails, light poles and electrical work on the stairs and footpath areas. The public address system and Opal card readers were also installed.

## Upcoming work

Ramp resurfacing will be completed in November after being postponed due to wet weather. Painting and drainage will continue, along with footpath work on Weber Crescent.

## Working hours

We will continue to work from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday**. Aside from weekend work listed below, some work on weekends may occur between **7am and 6pm Saturdays** and **8am and 6pm Sundays**.

## Weekend work

Resurfacing of the existing entry ramps on Platform 1 is planned for **Saturday 19 November** and **Sunday 20 November**. Buses will replace trains during this time.

*All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.*
