## Tuggerah Station Upgrade

### Project update - October 2022

#### The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability or limited mobility, parents/ carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Early work on the project started in June 2022 and is progressing well. Early work will continue until **late-January 2023**, weather permitting.

#### Early work activities

Transport and its contractor Downer will be continuing early work at Tuggerah Station in preparation for major work to start on the upgrade.

Over the next few months early work activities will include:

- non-destructive digging to locate services including electricity, gas and water
- relocation of vending machines, ticketing machines, passenger information displays, and removal of Telstra pay phones
- installing temporary, relocated pedestrian station entrances, pathways and ramps for station accessibility
- Removal of canopies on the Bryant Street and Pacific Highway entrances.
- establish site construction compounds and fencing at existing entrances at Bryant Drive carpark and Pacific Highway
- relocation of cabling on platform.

#### Temporary traffic, access and parking changes

During work hours, there may be occasional temporary traffic changes surrounding Tuggerah Station on the Pacific Highway and Bryant Drive.

Changes will be required to the car park as site compounds are established for construction. This includes temporary removal of up to 14 car parking spaces for the duration of the project. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists.

Pedestrian access may be changed at times with the installation of temporary pathways and ramps for safe access to the station, car park and bus stops. Signage will be in place to assist pedestrians.

We will notify residents and businesses in advance of changes to station access.

## Construction hours

**Standard work hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday, with no work on Sundays or on public holidays.**

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

## Out of hours work

Out of hours work is required on the project to complete conduit installation on Platform 1 between **4am and 7pm on Saturday 29 October** and **between 6am and 9pm on Sunday 30 October 2022** during a planned rail shutdown weekend. Work within the rail corridor must be timed to occur when the rail line is closed for maintenance.

This work will include the use of light vehicles and hand tools. Pedestrian access over the footbridge will be maintained at all times as well as safe movement of vehicles around the site.

## Next Steps

Transport is continuing to finalise the design of the Tuggerah Station upgrade. We expect to provide the community with an update in early-2023.
