The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station as part of the Transport Access Program. The upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Early work on the project started in June 2022 and is progressing well. Early work will continue until **October 2022**, weather permitting.

Early work activities completed over the last couple of months include investigations for electrical, sewer, stormwater, communications and rail signal services, drilling of bore holes for geotechnical investigations and vegetation removal.

Early work activities

Investigation work is continuing at Tuggerah Station, including non-destructive digging activities to locate underground services.

In late September we will be mobilising new site sheds in preparation for major work to start on the upgrade.

In October we will be carrying out trenching activities in the Tuggerah Station car park area and on Bryant Street. We will also be partially removing the bus canopy in Tuggerah Station car park and installing new external hoarding at the entrance to the station and on each station platform.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, 8am to 1pm Saturday and no work on Sundays or on public holidays. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Out of hours work

From **6pm** on **Monday 29 August** to **7am** on **Wednesday 31 August**, we will be carrying out service investigation work at the eastern entrance of Tuggerah Station. Activities will include site set up, demobilisation and the use of a vacuum truck.

Temporary traffic, access and parking changes

During the work to upgrade the station, there may be occasional temporary traffic changes surrounding Tuggerah Station on the Pacific Highway and Bryant Drive. These changes may include temporary parking removal to accommodate large vehicles during construction. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists.

We will notify residents and businesses in advance of changes to station access.
