The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

Completed work

During March, we continued to work on the new footbridge, lift pits, bridge piers, stairs and retaining walls and finalised the improvements to the existing station building, equipment room, ambulant toilet and station cleaning room.

The piling for the footbridge foundations on the car park side of the station was completed, and the heavy machinery used to do this work was relocated to the other side of the station to start the next stage of piling.

Upcoming work

This month we will be:

- trimming the footbridge and lift piles to the correct levels
- waterproofing and erecting scaffolding on the lift shafts
- excavating and pouring concrete for the bridge footings
- starting the second stage of piling work on the eastern side of Berkely Road in preparation for the new footbridge, lift, and stairs.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete trucks, crane, piling machinery, jackhammers, air compressor, delivery trucks and handheld tools.

Working hours

Most of this work will take place during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm Mondays to Fridays** and **Saturdays from 8am to 1pm**.

Weekend work

To compensate for delays caused by COVID-19, wet weather and ongoing industrial action, we will also be doing some work on weekends in April, May and June. This work will take place between **7am and 6pm on Saturdays** and **8am to 6pm Sundays**. These works have been assessed for noise and will not create any excessive noise.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Project delays

The ongoing industrial action within Sydney Trains has caused delays to the Unanderra Station Upgrade. It is likely that the construction program will continue until later than expected. We will update you with expected completion dates once the industrial action is over.

Commuter car park

All vehicles will continue to exit directly onto the Princes Highway, and some parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable until the completion of the project. There will be signage in the commuter car park directing you to the alternate council car park on Central Road should you need to use it.

Accessible parking has been temporarily relocated to the main car park area.

Pedestrian access

The pedestrian route from the commuter car park to the station is now via the footpath alongside the Princes Highway into Berkeley Road (West). Please allow more time than usual to park your car and walk to the station.
