

# Transport Access Program

## Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification | July 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

### Completed work

During June, we continued work on both sides of the station for the lift shafts, footbridge, and stair foundations. The high voltage power poles were permanently relocated to allow access to the area for lifting materials and continued work on the new footbridge.

### Upcoming work

In July, we will be working on both sides of the station and platform, carrying out formwork and steel reinforcement to continue building the footbridge substructure and lift shafts. Waterproofing will continue for the lift shafts and we will begin backfilling the excavated areas within the rail corridor. We will start work in the cul-de-sac on Berkely Road (East) for the new kiss and ride zone.

A section of this area will be closed while this work happens, although access across the existing footbridge into the station will be maintained. The taxi zone will be temporarily relocated about 50 metres further up the road.

## Working hours

Most work will occur during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **Saturdays from 8am to 1pm**.

To compensate for delays caused by COVID-19, wet weather and ongoing industrial action, we will also be carrying out some work on weekends between **7am and 6pm on Saturdays** and **8am to 6pm on Sundays**. The work will not create any excessive noise.

*All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.*

## Commuter car park

For the next few months, all parking will remain as it is now. All vehicles will continue to enter the car park from the Princes Highway via Berkeley Road and exit directly onto the Princes Highway.
