The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station.

This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.

The Unanderra Station Upgrade has begun with most work inside the existing station building now complete; including new staff areas and, a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet.

What we're doing

Work has started on the new footbridge which will be built in the centre of the platform with three connecting stairways and three lifts, replacing the existing footbridge.

Weekend work

We will be working between 5am on Saturday 22 January and 10pm on Sunday 23 January.

For the safety of staff and customers, this weekend work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period, when no trains will be running, and the station will be closed. There will be signage directing people to alternative transport.

The work being carried out over this weekend will include:

- excavating on the platform
- adjusting overhead track wiring and network high voltage power
- installing a new station electrical switchboard with a new fire-rated enclosure.

Machinery and tools that will be used include elevated work platform, cranes, concrete and delivery trucks, pole drilling trucks, lifting equipment, excavators and dump trucks.

Working hours

To support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has amended the rules around operating hours on work sites. Sites can now operate **seven days a week and on public holidays from 7am to 6pm.** These amendments allow worksites to support social distancing and the health and wellbeing of workers. To compensate for the delays caused by COVID-19 restrictions, the Unanderra Station Upgrade will be using the extended hours. Some staff may arrive before 7am to sign in, start COVID-19 safety checks and for pre-start meetings. Construction work will not begin until after 7am.
