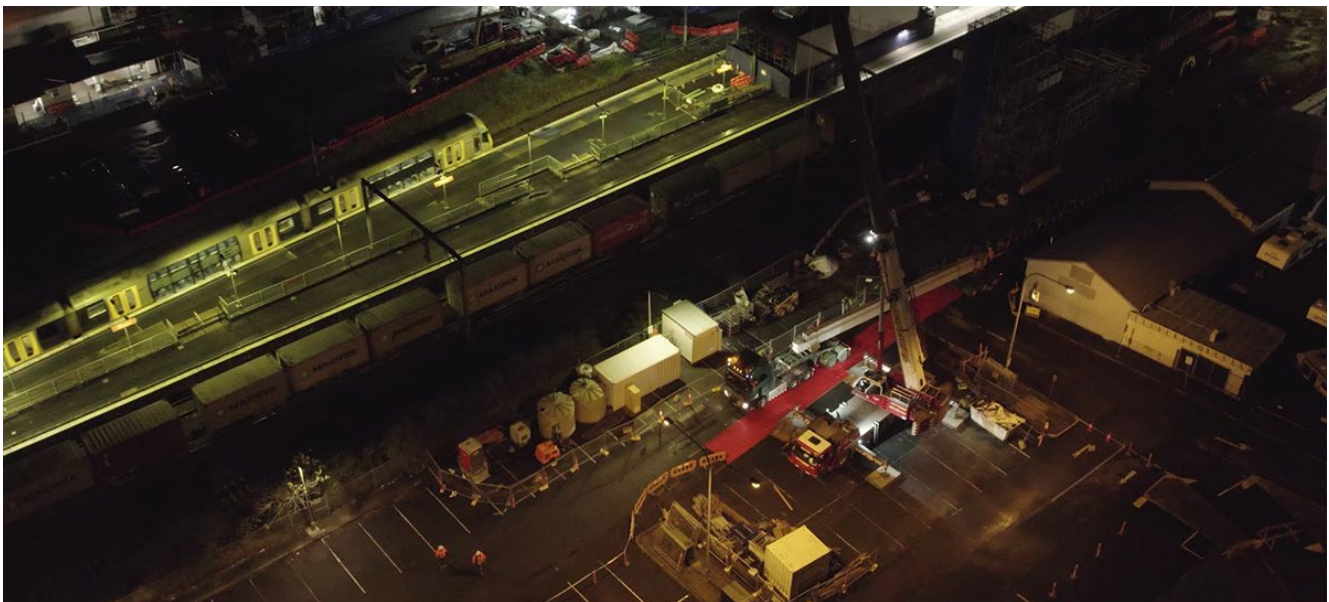


Transport Access Program

Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification October 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.



Bridge girders were delivered in preparation for the next stage of the new footbridge.

Completed work

In September work on both sides of the station and platform continued, including delivery of the concrete bridge girders. The girders are being stored inside the car park area currently used by the project. Work also continued on the stairs for the new footbridge and the kiss and ride zone in the cul-de-sac on Berkeley Road East.

Upcoming work

The next stage of the new footbridge, as well as finishing the bridge piers, stairs and the concrete lift shafts will take place in October. Work will continue on Berkeley Road East with the taxi zone, footpaths, landscaping, signage and line marking. The new kiss and ride and walkways on Berkeley Road West will also start.

Working hours and weekend work

Most work will be carried out between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **Saturdays between 8am and 1pm**. Due to delays we may also carry out some work using extra hours on weekends from **7am to 6pm on Saturdays** and **8am to 6pm on Sundays**. This should not create any excessive noise.

Works planned for early October to put the bridge girders in place have been postponed. There will no longer be work over the long weekend Saturday 1 October through Monday 3 October.
