

Transport Access Program Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification January 2023

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.



New coloured concrete footpaths are taking shape on Berkely Road West.

Completed work

Canopies were installed over the stairs on the platform and in the rail corridor in December. New stormwater pipes were installed on the platform and some areas resurfaced.

The footpaths, kiss and ride zones and accessible parking work started on the Berkeley Road West side of the station, including the pouring of the new coloured concrete footpaths.

Upcoming work

In January, glass will be installed on the lift shaft on the Berkeley Road East side and new stairs will be completed. Lighting and services will also be installed at the station entrance and plaza on the Berkeley Road East side.

On the Berkeley Road West side, the new lift will be installed as well as signage and handrails. Fencing on the retaining wall along the rail corridor will go up and more coloured concrete footpaths will be poured for access to the new stairs and lifts.

On the platform new lights and handrails will be installed.

Commuter car park

In mid-January there will be minor changes to traffic flow on the Loop Road on Berkeley Road West. Entry to the road and traffic direction will remain the same, but all vehicles will now drive on the right-hand side of the road.

There will be no change to the commuter car park entrance or exit, and pedestrian access to the station will remain the same.

Working hours and weekend work

Work will be carried out between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm Saturdays**. Some work may also be carried out on weekends in January through to the end of the project from **7am to 6pm Saturdays and 8am to 6pm Sundays**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.
