Waitara Station Upgrade – Project Update January 2023

Upcoming work

Work at the station is progressing well. During December excavation of the new station entry continued (from the commuter car park) and the underpass under one track (see photo above).

Work on site will resume on Monday 9 January 2023. Work planned for January includes:

- installing formwork, tying reinforcement and pouring concrete for underpass foundations, slabs, beams and plinths
- continuing shotcrete work to the sides of the excavation to help reinforce the walls of the underpass
- continuing excavation for the new lift and stairs and continuing with the underpass excavation
- removal of excavation spoil from the platform and underpass construction work areas
- minor electrical work around the station precinct.

Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, forklifts, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, power tools and hand tools.

Temporary closure of station toilets

The station toilets will be closed temporarily from **Friday 13 January 2023** to allow the facilities to be upgraded. Temporary toilets will be available for use at the Hornsby end of the island platform and will be open during the station's staffed hours from 6am to 12:30pm Monday to Friday. Directional signage will be in place to help customers with these temporary changes.

Temporary access, parking and traffic changes

Throughout our upgrade work, there may be temporary access and traffic changes on Alexandria Parade and Waitara Avenue commuter car park. This may require temporary single lane road closures and/or parking removal to accommodate large vehicles carrying out construction work. Traffic control and signage will be in place.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**, excluding public holidays. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
