Waitara Station Upgrade – Project Update July 2022



Upcoming work

Work at the station continues apace with foundations installed under the platform and tracks, and electrical services relocated during June. Work will continue in July and includes:

- piling for the lift and new underpass foundations on the island platform
- excavation for new lift and stairs
- removal of excavation spoil from the platform
- structural concrete pouring
- minor electrical work around the station precinct.

Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, forklifts, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, power tools and hand tools.

Weekend work - Saturday 23 to Monday 25 July

Work will be carried out **continuously from 2am Saturday 23 July until 4am Monday 25 July 2022.** For the safety of customers and our workers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when **trains are not operating and the station is closed**. The work will involve:

- installing foundations next to the tracks
- installing precast concrete below the tracks

- moving equipment using a mobile crane
- concrete work on the platform.

Equipment to be used includes mobile crane, delivery trucks, elevated work platforms, dump trucks, excavators, piling rigs, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, mobile lighting towers, jackhammers, compressors, demo saws, power and hand tools.

The equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work.

The commuter car park will be **temporarily closed** during this weekend work from **10pm Friday 22 July** until **4am Monday 25 July** to enable safe construction work.

Night work continuing during July

As it was notified previously, in July, night work will be carried out **two consecutive nights per week** (between Monday and Friday) from **1am to 4am**, weather permitting. This work will occur while train services are not operating to ensure the safety of our workers and the community.

Work will involve using a forklift to load materials and equipment on and off the platform. Other equipment includes work utes, task lighting, power and hand tools.

Temporary traffic, access and parking changes

Throughout our upgrade work at the station on occasion there may be temporary traffic and access changes surrounding the station, on Alexandria Parade and in the commuter car park on Waitara Avenue. This may involve a requirement for single lane road closures and/or parking removal to accommodate large vehicles carrying out construction work.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with all temporary changes. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance of changes to station access.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**, excluding public holidays. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
