Waitara Station Upgrade Construction Update – June 2022

Night work continuing from Monday 20 June

From **Monday 20 June until late July 2022** night work will be carried out two consecutive nights per week (between Monday and Friday) from **1am to 4am**, weather permitting. To ensure the safety of our workers and the community, this work will occur at night when train services are not operating.

Work will involve using a forklift to load materials and equipment on and off the platforms. Other equipment to be used includes work utes, task lighting, power and hand tools.

The equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with some noise associated with this work.

Upcoming work - remainder of June 2022

Work at the station continues to progress with construction site set up and vegetation clearing completed in early June including installing foundations under the platform and tracks, temporary hoarding and relocating electrical services. Work will continue throughout the remainder of June and will include:

- continuing piling on the platform behind temporary hoarding walls
- excavating on the platform behind temporary hoarding walls
- earthwork at the new underpass location including removing spoil from site
- site surveying.

Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, delivery trucks, telehandler (track mounted crane), power tools and hand tools.

Temporary traffic, access and parking changes

During the station upgrade there may be occasional temporary traffic and access changes surrounding Waitara Station, on Alexandria Parade and in the commuter car park on Waitara Avenue. This may involve a requirement for single lane road closures and/or parking removal to accommodate large vehicles carrying out construction work.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with all temporary changes. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance of changes to station access.

We thank you for your patience as we carry out this important work.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**, excluding public holidays.

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
