Transport for NSW is upgrading Wollstonecraft Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work in March

Work at Wollstonecraft Station will continue in March and will include:

- stormwater drainage work such as gutter and downpipe modifications
- bird proofing on cameras, lights and signage
- wayfinding installation
- removal and reinstatement of the footpath, kerb, driveway, and refuge island on Shirley Road and Telopea Street
- installation of fencing along the new kerb

- removal and reinstatement of line marking for the accessible parking and kiss and ride area
- electrical work to upgrade the power supply on Platform 2.

We will require the use of equipment including an excavator, dump truck, compactor, concrete vibrator, demolition saw, jackhammer and other powered hand tools to carry out these works.

Our work will be carried out in stages so access to the station is maintained. However, there will be some diversions in place for customers, accessing both Platform 1 and 2. Please follow the temporary signs and traffic controller's directions.

Night work in March

For the safety of our workers, pedestrians, and motorists, electrical night work will take place on **Wednesday 9 March** between **6pm to 7am**.

In late March, the installation of accessible and kiss and ride parking and the removal and reinstatement of the kerb, ramp, and driveway along Shirley Road and Telopea Street will commence. Residents will receive further information about this work prior to commencing.

There may be some noise associated with these works. While we expect this to be minimal, we will ensure every effort is made to minimise noise. We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience and understanding while we deliver this important upgrade.

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
