

Yagoona Station Upgrade

Community Update – August 2022



Work is now complete

The upgrade of Yagoona Station is now complete, delivering the first hands free lift on the Sydney Trains network. Accessibility at the station has been improved, with the following facilities now available:

- new lift and stairs connecting the concourse to the station platform
- new concourse at the station entry
- new station building and facilities
- additional platform canopies to provide continuous cover from the new lift and stairs to the platform
- new accessible parking spaces
- new kiss and ride area on Hume Highway
- new accessible pathways
- family accessible toilet and male and female ambulant toilets
- upgrades to CCTV and lighting

693 people worked on the project



44,000 hours worked



80 tonnes of structural steel used



170 cubic metres of concrete poured

Local and sustainable materials, including steel and concrete, were sourced for the project, which resulted in a 22-tonne reduction in carbon dioxide emissions.

Adding to our commitment for sustainability, 94% of construction waste was diverted from landfill since construction commenced. In addition, 30 trees were planted at Yagoona Public School in July 2022 to help improve biodiversity and shade cover in the area.
