## **Vehicle Information Forms**

## Purpose:

To advise Proprietors and Examiners that forms 1122 and 1213 have been combined to simplify the request and approval processes. It remains as Form 1122 Request for Vehicle Information.

**Note:** Form 1213 is no longer in use and you must now use Form 1122 when requesting trailer identification numbers for pre-1989 trailers.

## What has changed and what do I need to do?

The requirements for photos and material receipts have been updated for both homemade and pre-1989 trailer applications to streamline the approval process.

The updated Form 1122 Request for Vehicle Information is to be used for the following requests:

- Replacement VIN, Chassis number, or Engine number
- Individually Constructed Vehicle (ICV) VIN
- Homemade light trailer VIN
- Homemade heavy trailer VIN
- Pre-1989 Trailer identification number

If a customer is requesting a homemade trailer VIN or pre-1989 trailer identification number, the customer must supply you with the following items for submission with Form 1122:

- clear photos of all four sides of the trailer and draw bar
- receipts for parts and materials used to construct the trailer

# **Background:**

A more thorough identity check is conducted by TfNSW to establish the identity and legitimacy of homemade and pre-1989 trailers. This is due to the higher risk of fraudulent and stolen activity relating to these trailer types.

In accordance with Rule 221, the Authorised Examiner must obtain a VIN from the VINs unit for homemade trailers. Form 1122 Request for Vehicle Information is used for this purpose and emailed to <a href="mailto:vins@transport.nsw.gov.au">vins@transport.nsw.gov.au</a>. To confirm the legitimacy of a trailer, TfNSW will request photos and material receipts with the Request for Vehicle Information form.

In July 2018 AIS Notice 37 was issued outlining amendments to the trailer identity check standards for pre-1989 trailers. This included the requirement to complete Form 1213 to request a vehicle identification number for the trailer and the submission of photos and material receipts.
