


Commuter Car Park Program Beverly Hills

More commuter car parking is coming to Beverly Hills Station


Planning is underway to deliver additional commuter car parking spaces at Beverly Hills Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is funded by NSW Government's Commuter Car Park Program.

The proposed commuter car park is located off Edgbaston Road adjacent to the railway corridor, around 70 metres south west of Beverly Hills Station. A new multi-storey car park at this location will provide safe, accessible and convenient commuter parking close to the station, and help meet the growing demand for commuter parking in the area.

Key features of the proposal include:

- a multi-storey commuter car park with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces
- lift and stairs access to each level
- CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage for safety and security
- provision for future electric vehicle charging points
- Transport for NSW Park&Ride infrastructure (Opal card-operated boom gates)
- upgrade of existing stairs that link the existing car park to King Georges Road
- four accessible parking spaces located on Tooronga Terrace
- landscaping.

Transport for NSW will be working closely with Georges River Council during the planning and the construction of the car park. Subject to Planning Approval, construction is planned to start in mid-2022 and finish in late 2023.



Provide your feedback

An environmental impact assessment in the form of a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) has been prepared for the project. The REF outlines a number of factors relating to the proposal including traffic, noise, visual and community impacts during both construction and operation of the car park. The REF also identifies potential mitigation measures that would be implemented to ensure these impacts are appropriately managed during both construction and operation to reduce the disturbance to the local residents and businesses around the car park.
