

Extension of working hours at Coffs Harbour Regional Boat Ramp

The NSW Government is currently working to upgrade the Coffs Harbour Regional Boat Ramp. Due to several circumstances, we need to extend our hours of work on Saturdays.

Since we last contacted the community, work has begun on the boat ramp upgrade and to take advantage of favourable tidal conditions and longer daylight hours, we have found it necessary to increase our hours of work on Saturdays so we can keep the project on track in accordance with our projections.

We are already working from will be working between **7.00am** and **5.00pm** from **Monday - Friday** and between **8.00am** and **1.00pm** on **Saturday**.

We have extended the working hours on **Saturdays** to **7.00am-4.00pm**.

How will this affect you?

Disruption to boat ramp users will be minimal. We have already promised that:

- At least two lanes of the boat ramp will remain open during most of the construction work, with only short periods with no access. We will take steps to avoid full ramp closure on Saturdays.
- There may be some restricted parking and delayed access to a boat ramp lane due to some road lanes being closed off for work.
- Work on the pontoon and dredging may temporarily restrict movements in the bay. Boat users and visitors will need to take extra care in manoeuvring their vessels in and out of the harbour.
- Stage 1 is expected to affect road traffic in the area. There will be truck movements delivering equipment, materials and rock for the breakwater, as well as taking away debris. Traffic control measures will be in place during this work to maintain safety and control.

All this timing change means is that workers and equipment will be active for a longer period on Saturdays. All other conditions will remain the same.
