# Works recently completed

The Denistone team successfully completed concrete pours of the two lift shafts and installed new utility infrastructure for station power and communication supply along the platform.

We also commenced work on the new family accessible bathroom.

# December - January work:

- Finish the brickwork around both lifts & remove scaffolding
- Install new utility infrastructure for station power and communication supply along Gordon Crescent side entrance, platform and garden beds.
- Investigate and relocate services.
- Upgrade stormwater pipework throughout the station including work on West Parade.
- Construct new toilet facilities and work on the waiting room on Platforms 3 and 4.
- Upgrade Gordon Crescent carpark, including installing an accessible car space.

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#### Our work schedule

Our work hours are between **7am** and **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

There will be no work on public holidays and we will not work from Friday 23 December 2022 to Sunday 8 January 2023, to help the community enjoy an undisrupted holiday break.

We are aiming to have the station upgrade complete by late 2023. Some of our works can only be done during scheduled Sydney Trains track work periods, when trains are not running.

Unfortunately, much of our planned weekend and night works have been delayed due to industrial action. We will ensure to keep the community updated with any changes.

# How will our work affect you?

We understand that our work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to lessen the disturbance, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Temporary changes may be in place during our work hours to safely detour people around the work zone.

# Carparking and facilities

The Kinson Crescent car park is partially closed and will be used by our project team for the duration of the project.

For the Gordon Crescent Car park, five car parking spaces will be occupied for three days at a time in December for construction work. The whole carpark will be closed in January, during school holidays, to complete works.

While the family accessible toilet is being built the female toilets are closed. Male toilets have been converted to unisex on the opposite side of the station building.

The waiting room on platforms 3 and 4 will also be closed until the waiting room work is complete.

We appreciate your patience while we complete the family accessible toilet and the waiting room upgrade.
