Project Update

Structural work on the new Edmondson Park North Commuter Car Park continued to progress during October, with civil work finalised for the main structure. Two tower cranes were successfully installed, commissioned and are now in use. The main structural trades, footings and vertical structural elements work have commenced.

Upcoming work

Work activities planned for November include:

- concreting work for the lift and stair walls
- in-ground stormwater work
- ground floor slab construction

Equipment to be used will include excavators, rollers, road saws, graders, tipping trucks, concrete mixers, concrete pump trucks, service vehicles, various delivery vehicles, mobile cranes, tower cranes, forklifts, generators, and hand tools.

Construction hours

Standard work hours are between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak times wherever possible to minimise disruption to pedestrians and motorists.
