



Commuter Car Park Program

Emu Plains

Community Notification | November 2022

Project overview

Transport for NSW is constructing a new commuter car park at Emu Plains Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments. The car park, which will be accessed via a new roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street, will provide approximately 750 additional commuter parking spaces.

Progress update and upcoming work

Work has progressed well through October despite the ongoing rainfall, and key activities have included asphaltting of the commuter car park, and construction of one of the stormwater detention ponds.

The following work is planned to occur in November:

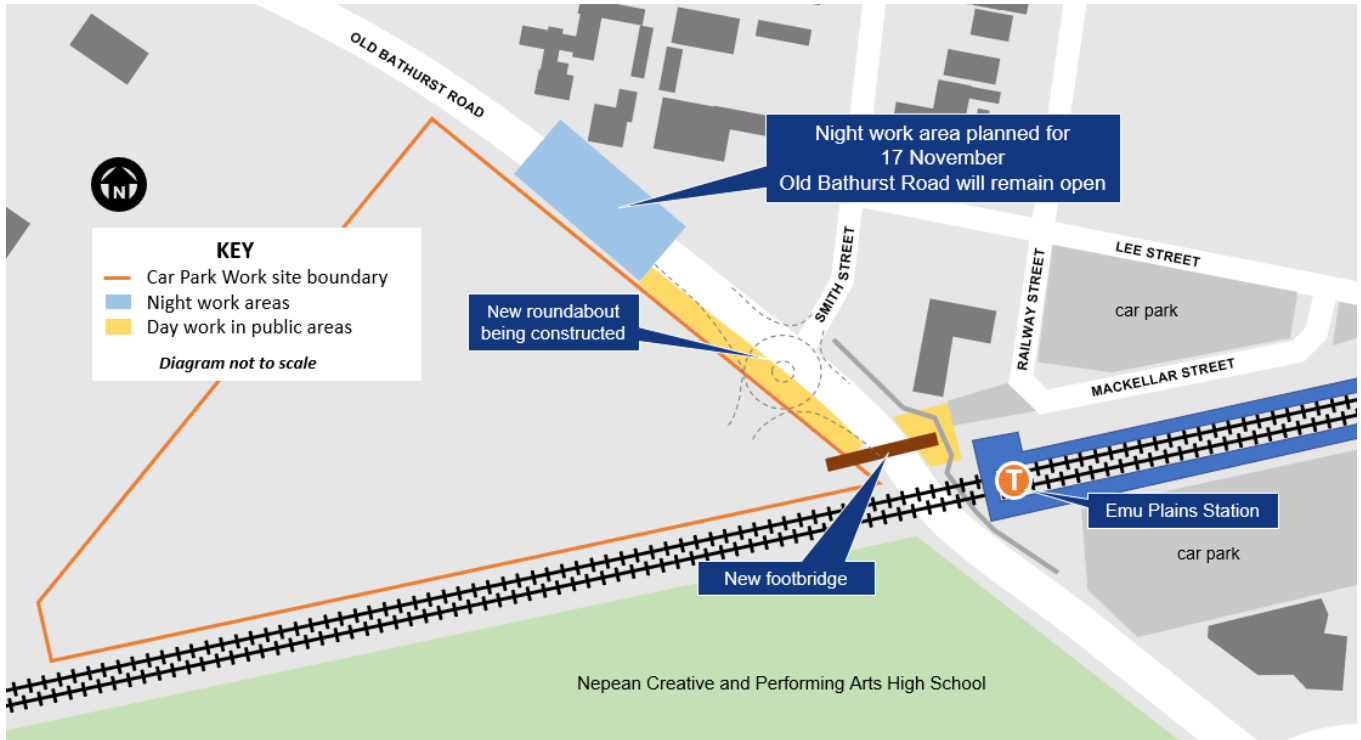
- Constructing kerbs and footpaths along Old Bathurst Road
- Constructing stairs and footpaths at the station end of the new footbridge
- Continuing management of vegetation including tree removal if required
- Continuing asphalt work
- Utilities work including stormwater drainage, and construction of protection slabs
- Line marking, wheel stops and fixtures installation
- Lighting installation
- Landscaping and fencing in the car park.

Minor traffic flow changes will be made as required. Some short periods of daytime contra-flow (two-way traffic but one lane at a time under traffic control) may be necessary for line marking on Old Bathurst Road. Please observe signage and the directions of traffic controllers. Equipment to be used will include excavators, road saw, rollers and compactors, tipping trucks, concrete mixers, asphalt machine, service vehicles, various delivery vehicles, generators, lighting towers for night work, an elevated work platform and hand tools.

Night work in November

Subject to approval and weather permitting, a section of **Old Bathurst Road will have a temporary single lane closure for night work from 9pm Thursday 17 November to 5am Friday 18 November (workers will be on site from 6pm)**. Please see work location overleaf. This will allow for the safe installation of a high voltage power pole. Traffic will be in a contra-flow arrangement (two-way traffic but one lane at a time under traffic control). Construction plant and equipment will include an excavator, mobile crane, an elevated working platform, generators, service vehicles, and hand tools. Anyone who may be impacted by this work will be contacted directly.
