Commuter Car Park Program

Emu Plains

Community Notification | October 2022

Project overview

Transport for NSW is constructing a new commuter car park at Emu Plains Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments. The car park, which will be accessed via a new roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street, will provide approximately 750 additional commuter parking spaces.

Progress update and upcoming work

Asphalting of the car park is progressing and is now approximately 60% complete. Lighting and electrical work have also progressed through September.

The following work is planned to occur in October:

- kerb and footpath construction along **Old Bathurst Road**
- vegetation management including tree removal work
- continued asphalting work
- line marking, wheel stops and fixtures installation
- lighting installation
- landscaping and fencing installation.

require ongoing traffic management, with minor traffic flow changes being

implemented. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place for the safety of motorists and workers. Equipment to be used will include excavators, road saw, rollers and compactors, tipping trucks, concrete mixers, asphalt machine, service vehicles, various delivery vehicles, generators, lighting towers for nightwork, an elevated work platform and hand tools.

Night work in October

Subject to approval, sections of Old Bathurst Road will be closed for night work currently being planned for 20-22 October and 27-29 October, to carry out gas main protection and stormwater drainage work. Access to Smith Street will be maintained via Russell Street. Please note there is a low clearance of 4.5m at the Russell Street rail underpass.


All work is subject to weather, COVID and site conditions and may change without notice. A further notification about night work will be provided to nearby residents and businesses before work starts.

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays. All work is dependent on weather, site conditions and COVID restrictions and may be varied without additional notice.
