# **Glossop Street, St Marys**

#### **Completion of works April 2022**

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) has completed upgrades to the Glossop Street widening on the northbound carriageway between Phillip Street and Hobart Street and dedicated left turn slip lane to access the future Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport services facility at St Marys.

The Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. The city-shaping project will deliver new stations at St Marys, Orchard Hills, Luddenham, Airport Business Park, Airport Terminal and the Western Sydney Aerotropolis. The 23 kilometre new railway is planned to open at the same time as passenger services start at the airport.



### Works completed

The upgraded intersection and newly constructed driveway is now complete. Our work included:

- widening the northbound carriageway from two lanes to three with a dedicated slip lane for vehicles to access the rail corridor
- · upgrading the road median and footpaths
- · new signage and line marking
- · relocation of utilities and stormwater drainage improvements
- new street landscaping and pedestrian footpath
