March work

Throughout March at Pymble Station, we will be working on:

- · constructing the new lifts
- upgrading the toilets on the station platform
- clearing vegetation
- planned tree removing on Grandview Street
- excavating and installing new footings
- installing cable routes
- preparing a work area in the Pacific Highway car park for a new electrical pit
- installing a new electrical padmount within the rail corridor and the Pacific Highway car park.

Grandview Street temporary closures

Grandview Street (between Station Street and Alma Street) will experience temporary closures to allow for the new precast concrete lift and new power poles to be installed during:

- midnight Saturday 12 March to midnight Monday 14 March
- midnight Saturday 26 March to 11pm Sunday 27 March.

Access to residential properties on Grandview Street will be maintained under traffic control directions.

During the road closure, shops along Grandview Street will remain open and pedestrian access will be available to the shops along Grandview Street between Station Street and Alma Street.



Temporary removal of car parking on Grandview Street (Station Street to Wellesley Road)


To allow for deliveries and preparation for weekend work, car parking spaces will be unavailable on Grandview Street, between Station Street and Wellesley Road:

 from 7am Friday 4 March to midnight Monday 14 March, around 15 car parking spaces.

How will the work effect you?

Equipment used throughout March includes excavators, vacuum truck, road saw, tipper truck, flatbed truck, tilt tray, concrete truck and pump, cranes, elevated working platforms, lighting towers, dump trucks, auger, grinder, chain saw, chipper, various hand and power.

Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with this work, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.



Pacific Highway car park temporary closure and temporary removal of car parking spaces

The Pacific Highway Car Park, will be closed during works on:

- Saturday 12 March and Sunday 13 March
- Saturday 26 March and Sunday 27 March.

On the southern end of the Pacific Highway Car Park, around 11 car parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable from Monday 14 March 2022 to Friday 1 April 2022.

This will allow for work of the new electrical pit to be carried out.
