Project update

February - April 2022

Upcoming construction work in February, March and April

Construction on the Revesby commuter car park extension is progressing well and work is expected to be completed mid 2022. Activities from February 2022 to April 2022 will include:

- · installation of a temporary construction zone on Simmons Street
- installation of site hoarding on Haydock Lane and Simmons Street
- continued demolition and removal of existing façade panels on the rooftop to enable the extension of the car park
- structural strengthening works on the lower levels of the car park
- · concrete columns and slabs for the new car park floors
- installation of new glazing panels for the eastern lift
- formwork and concrete slabs for new car park floor
- scaffold installation for Haydock Lane glazing works.

Changes to commuter parking

Commuter parking on level 3B and 4A will be temporarily unavailable until **early April 2022** to enable construction of additional parking levels to progress. The eastern lift of the commuter car park is currently closed until **5pm Saturday 23 April 2022** to allow for the extension of the lift..

The rooftop of the multi-storey car park will remain closed for the duration of construction. Council parking on the lower levels will remain open during construction. As work progresses, some commuter parking on lower levels will also become temporarily unavailable to complete the extension work safely. Signage will be in place to notify commuters of these changes.

We will endeavour to make parking spaces available as early as possible throughout the construction program, and will notify customers of additional parking availability. Please plan your journey ahead of time as it may take longer than usual to find a parking space. If possible, please consider alternative transport options to and from the station or flexible working arrangements during this time.

Park&Ride

Park&Ride is now operational at Revesby Commuter Car Park. Park&Ride allows you to access up to 18 hours free parking each day when you complete a trip on public transport by tapping on and tapping off with the same Opal card.

How to use Transport Park&Ride at Revesby:

- Park your vehicle in Revesby Park&Ride Commuter Car Park.
- Tap on and tap off with an accepted Opal card to complete a trip on any public transport service.
 This will validate your free parking.
- Use the same Opal card to tap out of the car park within 18 hours of entering.

If you do not qualify for free parking, fees will apply. For more information, please visit transport.info/parkandride.

Park&Ride does not apply to the Council operated parking spaces within the carpark.

Construction hours

Work will take place during standard construction hours between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak times wherever possible to minimise disruption to pedestrians and motorists.
