

# Commuter Car Park Program

Revesby

Project update

July 2021

Transport for NSW is providing additional commuter parking at Revesby, to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. This project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments.

Planning approval for the project was granted in March following community consultation. Summary of community feedback was captured in the Determination Report and May 2021 Community Notification. The project will provide the community with approximately 385 additional commuter parking spaces by adding two storeys to the western side, and three storeys to the eastern side of the existing multi-storey car park. The extension of the existing commuter car park is expected to be completed and open to commuters in early 2022.

## Site establishment – from Friday 9 July

From **Friday 9 July**, our contractor ADCO, will establish site to commence construction on the car park extension. As part of site establishment, a temporary construction zone will be installed on Simmons Street. Site amenities and accommodation will be installed under level 1B along The River Road. Please see map below for an overview of site establishment.

## Upcoming changes to commuter parking – from Friday 23 July

In order to complete work on the new car park safely, on **Friday 23 July** the **rooftop** of the multi-storey car park will close for the duration of construction. All commuters will need to exit the rooftop by **10am Saturday 24 July**. Council parking on the lower levels will remain open during construction.

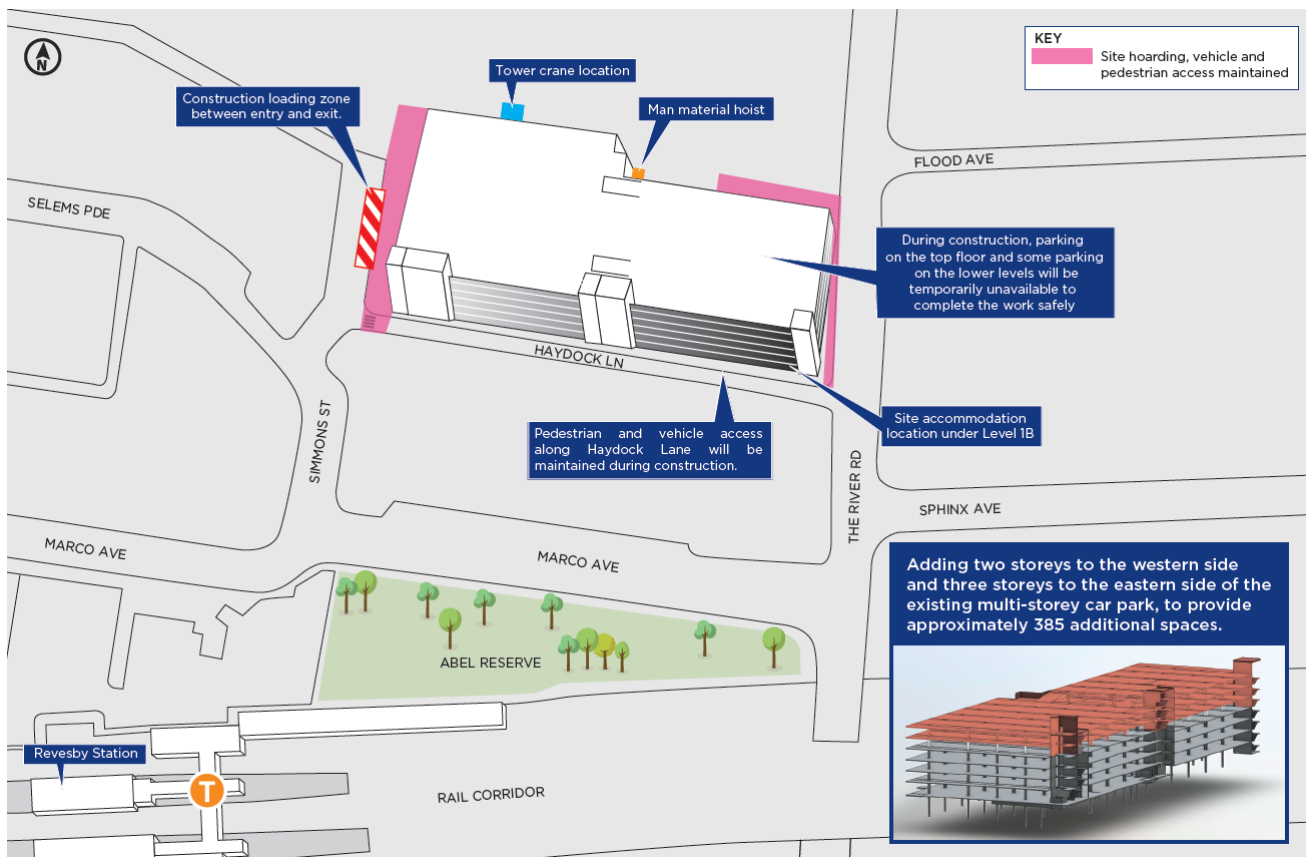
From late July as construction work progresses, commuter parking on lower levels will also become temporarily unavailable to complete the extension work safely.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience our work may cause. We will endeavour to make parking spaces available as early as possible throughout the construction program, and will notify customers of additional parking availability. It may take you longer than usual to find a parking space. Plan your journey ahead of time. If possible, please consider alternative transport options to and from the station or flexible working arrangements during this time.

## Transport Park&Ride

Transport Park&Ride is currently being installed on the commuter parking levels in the multi-storey car park and will be operational in the coming months. Transport Park&Ride provides up to 18 hours free parking each day. All you have to do is complete a public transport journey by tapping on and off using an accepted Opal card, then use that Opal card when you exit the car park. You can access real-time car park occupancy data via the AnyTrip app to see how many parking spaces are available at Revesby by help you better plan your trip.

## Upcoming construction work

During July and August, the following work will occur for the new car park extension:

- A site compound will be established under level 1B along The River Road
- One tree will be removed. This tree will be replaced with landscaping at the end of the project
- Fencing and shade cloth will be installed around the site compound
- Demolition and removal of existing structural elements on the rooftop of the multi-storey car park to enable the extension of the car park
- Extension of the lift shafts and stair wells will be undertaken
- Façade upgrades to existing levels will commence in early August

In late August a tower crane will be installed on site to facilitate construction of the additional levels. Installation of the tower crane may occur over the weekend and require temporary road closures. We will update the community before this work occurs.

Existing lifts and stairs to access the ground floor will remain open and accessible to commuters during construction.

## Construction hours

Work will take place during standard construction hours between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak times wherever possible to minimise disruption to pedestrians and motorists.
