Revesby

Project update

October 2021

Transport for NSW is providing additional commuter parking at Revesby, to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. This project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments.

After consulting with the community and other stakeholders in February 2021, a summary of the feedback received was captured in a Determination Report and planning approval for the project was granted. Visit www.transport.nsw.gov.au/revesby to see the documentation.

The project will provide the community with approximately 385 additional commuter parking spaces by adding two storeys to the western side, and three storeys to the eastern side of the existing multi-storey car park. The extension of the existing commuter car park is expected to be completed and open to commuters in early 2022.

Upcoming construction work

During October, the following activities will take place for the car park extension:

- Site establishment work including erecting a temporary construction zone on Simmons Street
- Demolition and removal of existing structural elements on the rooftop to enable the extension of the car park
- Installation of site hoarding on Haydock Lane & Simmons Street
- Installation of man hoist on northern side of car park
- Extension of the lift shafts and stair wells.
- Structural strengthening works for lower car park floors.

On **Saturday 16 October** a tower crane will be installed on site to facilitate construction of the additional levels. Work to install the tower crane will require temporary road closures.

If the tower crane cannot be installed on this date due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, the work will be rescheduled to **Saturday 23 October**.

The existing lift and stairs to access the ground floor will remain open and accessible to commuters during construction.

Changes to commuter parking

From **early October to early December 2021**, commuter parking on level 3B and 4A will be temporarily unavailable to enable construction of additional parking levels to progress.

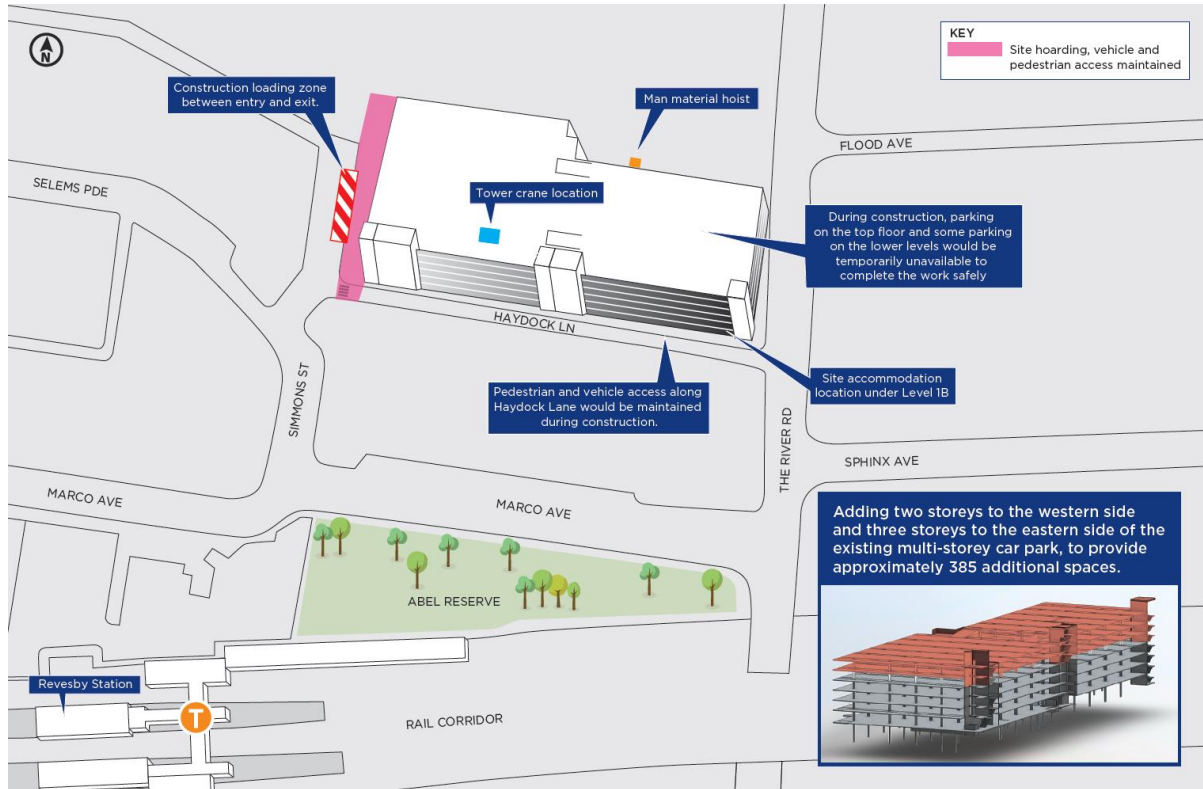
The eastern lift of the commuter car park is currently closed until **5pm Saturday 17 December** to allow construction of additional commuter parking and the extension of lift and stairs.

The rooftop of the multi-storey car park will also remain closed for construction. Council parking on the lower levels will remain open during construction.

As work progresses, some commuter parking on lower levels will also become temporarily unavailable to complete the extension work safely. Signage will be in place to notify commuters of these changes.

We will endeavour to make parking spaces available as early as possible throughout the construction program, and will notify customers of additional parking availability. Please plan your journey ahead of time as it may take longer than usual to find a parking space. If possible, please consider alternative transport options to and from the station or flexible working arrangements during this time.

Transport Park&Ride

Transport Park&Ride is currently being installed on the commuter parking levels in the multi-storey car park and will be operational in the coming months. Transport Park&Ride provides up to 18 hours free parking each day. All you have to do is complete a public transport journey by tapping on and off using an accepted Opal card, then use that Opal card when you exit the car park. You can access real-time car park occupancy data via the AnyTrip app to see how many parking spaces are available at Revesby to help you better plan your trip.

Construction hours

Work will take place during standard construction hours between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak times wherever possible to minimise disruption to pedestrians and motorists.

How are we staying safe

The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-19 Safe plan is in place, including masks and QR codes.
