

Construction work continuing at Schofields Commuter Carpark from 1 February 2022


February 2022

Transport for NSW is delivering approximately 700 additional commuter parking spaces at Schofields to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The car park is expected to be open to commuters in mid-2022.

From 1 February 2022 to 28 February 2022, at the Schofields Commuter Car Park work site, we will be:

- delivering and removing plant, equipment and materials
- adjusting site fencing and amenities
- installing services
- levelling the site
- kerb and gutter construction activities.

These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-Safe plan is in place, including the use of face masks and QR codes.



Our work schedule

Our work hours will be between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday**, weather permitting. If any additional work is required outside of these hours, the community will be notified in advance.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, using noise blankets, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers. You may notice an increase in construction vehicle movements and dust. Our team will be monitoring these activities and where possible, put dust control measures in place.
