Transport Access Program St Peters Station Upgrade



The St Peters Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents and carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

What we are doing in April

Standard working hours are Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm. We will be:

- glazing, welding and waterproofing the new lift shaft
- installing new anti-slip stair strips to the existing platform stairs. This will be done in stages, so stairs remain open for train services
- modifying the existing station toilets to become one family accessible toilet
- upgrading the Station Manager's office
- landscaping and upgrading footpaths on Lord Street and May Lane adjacent to the station
- installing services in the ground at the Lord Street rail access gate

Work schedules are **subject to change due to permits**, **inclement weather and site conditions**.

What to expect

- **intermittent periods of high noise** equipment used includes generators, trucks, gurney, circular saw, jack hammers, crane, compactor, excavator, telehandler, scissor lift, and various hand and power tools. Measures to reduce noise will be implemented, including turning equipment off when not in use, positioning equipment as far away from residences as possible, using non-tonal reversing beepers, and stopping work for respite periods
- **temporary loss of parking** up to eight car parking spaces around the Lord Street access gate will be required to facilitate vehicle access. No parking signage will be installed.
- **intermittent footbridge closures** access to the station from Lord Street will be restricted at times. Access via Goodsell Street and Railway Laneway will remain open, Lord Street users can access the station via King Street / Princes Highway.
- **increase in construction traffic** vehicles will access the rail corridor via Council Street, Concord Street and the Lord Street rail access gates.
