## St Peters Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

JANUARY / FEBRUARY 2022

The St Peters Station Upgrade is part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

### Upcoming out of hours work

During January and February, we will work standard construction hours during the week and on the weekends listed below. Work during this time includes installing new drainage and services and installing the new lifts and new canopy columns as well as canopies onto the platforms. We will also be resurfacing Platforms 1-2 and 3-4 at the southern ends and reinstating station furniture.

- **From Saturday 22 January to Sunday 23 January**, we will be installing services and drainage and then asphalt resurfacing on **Platform 1-2** at the south end (towards Sydenham). This includes removing the existing platform surface beforehand. We may also start to install the new lift shafts and new canopy columns and canopies onto the platforms.
- **From Saturday 5 February to Sunday 6 February**, we will be installing the new lift shafts and new canopy columns and canopies onto the platforms.
- **From Saturday 19 February to Sunday 20 February**, we will be installing services and drainage and then we will asphalt resurfacing on **Platform 3-4** at the south end (towards Sydenham). This includes removing the existing platform surface beforehand. We may need to complete installing the new lift shafts and new canopy columns and canopies onto the platforms.

**Intermittent Station Footbridge closures** are expected during this work meaning access from Lord Street will be restricted at times. Station access from Goodsell Street and Railway Laneway will remain open, Lord Street users can access this via King Street / Princes Highway. Traffic control will be in place to direct traffic and pedestrians when needed.

Equipment includes; dump trucks, excavator, generator, trucks, asphaltting truck, elevated work platform, gurney, rollers, concrete truck and pump, rattle gun, spider crane, and various hand and power tools.

*Work during the weekends will include overnight shifts.*

*Work including crane lifts is weather permitting.*

## Deliveries and access to the rail corridor

We will be delivering work material and machinery into the rail corridor from Concord Street and Lord Street. For work on Saturday 19 February and Sunday 20 February, we will also use Council Street.

Materials excavated from the drainage and services work will be stockpiled within the rail corridor during the weekend work and removed via truck during the weekdays.

This work will be carried out during a temporary Sydney Trains trackwork possession. For up-to-date information about bus replacement services during this time visit **transportnsw.info** or call **131 500**.

## What you may notice

This work will be noisy at times and due to the nature of the asphaltting resurfacing work, we will be working through the night to complete the work, weather permitting. Wherever possible, measures to reduce noise will be implemented, including turning equipment off when not in use, positioning equipment as far away from residences as possible, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience. while we carry out these important works.
