Thornleigh Station Upgrade

The Thornleigh Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage. We thank you for your patience during this important work.

What's next at Thornleigh?

Throughout April and May, work will include:

- constructing new lifts and canopies on the platform
- landscaping work on The Esplanade, the station entrance will remain accessible at all times during this work.
- upgrading the station toilets to a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet and upgrading station waiting rooms
- removal of spoil and materials from the rail corridor under traffic control supervision

Temporary closure of station toilets

Towards the end of **April** until **July 2022**, the station toilets will be temporarily closed to allow for a conversion to a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet.

During this period, a temporary toilet, that will be signposted will be available for use by station customers.

How will this work effect you?

Our work will use a range of equipment, excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, tipper trucks, flatbed trucks, tilt trays, concrete trucks and pumps, elevated working platforms, lighting towers, dump trucks, augers, grinders, chain saws, chippers, and various hand and power tools.

Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with this work, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours include **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday**.

Changes to scheduled work

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions. Notification will be provided should there be changes to the construction program.

Laydown area – Pennant Hills

From May 2022, a laydown area for materials will be established adjacent to the rail corridor off Station Street, Pennant Hills. This laydown area will remain in place until the project is completed. Access to properties will be maintained.

Project Update

Transport for NSW, in consultation with Hornsby Shire Council, is taking active steps to improve and build a safer solution for pedestrians and traffic on Railway Parade by extending the scope of work as part of the Thornleigh Station Upgrade project.

Road safety measures, including a raised pedestrian crossing, will be delivered to address concerns associated with pedestrian movements across Railway Parade, and to improve connectivity to Thornleigh Station.

This work is expected to start in early July.
