Transport Access Program Thornleigh Station Upgrade



The Thornleigh Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage. We thank you for your patience during this important work.

February work

Throughout February, work at Thornleigh Station will continue with:

- ongoing construction of the new lifts, including installation of CCTV within the station precinct
- upgrades to the station platform waiting rooms
- upgrades to the station toilets, to a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet.

Out of hours work

Saturday 26 February and Sunday 27 February between 12am and 11pm, we will be working in and around Thornleigh Station to;

- Remove redundant power pole cables
- Install a new power pole cable
- Excavate within the rail corridor to allow for a new electrical pad mount to be installed
- Excavate for drainage pits and drainage route within the Benowie Walkway and the rail corridor

The Thornleigh Station Upgrade team will also be working on **Saturday 12 March and Sunday 13 March.** We will notify residents and businesses closer to the date.

How will the work effect you?

Equipment used throughout February includes excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, jackhammers, tipper trucks, concrete trucks with pumps, dump trucks, lighting towers, elevated working platforms, crane various hand and power tools.
