Transport Access Program Thornleigh Station Upgrade



The Thornleigh Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage. We thank you for your patience during this important work.

March work

Throughout March at Thornleigh Station, we will continue with:

- ongoing construction of the new lifts and new canopies on the platform
- upgrading the station platform waiting rooms
- upgrading the station toilets, to a new family accessible toilet and a unisex ambulant toilet.

Out of hours work

Saturday 12 March from 5am to 11pm Sunday 13 March we will be working on:

- installing a new electrical padmount transformer
- installing new audio induction loop systems around the station precinct
- installing scaffolding around the lifts
- installing containment pipes for services to the station footbridge.

Benowie Walkway closure extension

Last year we notified you of the temporary closure of the Benowie Walkway from September 2021 to April 2022.

We have to continue with this closure to **late June 2022.** This is due to a number of factors including supply and resourcing issues resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, limited power outage permits and loss of trackwork weekend possessions.

We apologise for this inconvenience and thank you for your patience while we carry out this important work.

How will the work effect you?

Equipment used throughout March includes excavators, vacuum trucks, road saws, jackhammers, tipper trucks, concrete trucks with pumps, dump trucks, lighting towers, elevated working platforms, crane various hand and power tools.

Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with this work, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, turning off equipment when not in use, placing equipment as far away as possible from properties and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
