
# **Transport Visiting Fellowship Program**

The Transport Visiting Fellowship program is a short-term talent placement program that recruits PhD graduates on a temporary basis. The paid program is designed to foster a talent pipeline of specialists to build capability within Transport, addressing future skills gaps, particularly in new and emerging areas of work.

## What is involved?

Projects vary but you will be required to:

- undertake applied research matched to your specialist skills in areas such as technology and innovation analytics, engineering, business, and economics
- work autonomously and in small teams to help in project coordination
- contribute to project deliverables with little supervision
- work flexibly and manage your time.

Projects will provide a mix of three and six month placements, including both full-time and part-time opportunities. Salary range varies.
