Waitara Station Upgrade

Project Update - Site investigations May 2022

Waitara Station Upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure, especially for people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

As part of the planning process, further preliminary investigation work is required to help inform and progress the project design.

Upcoming work

Site investigations will be carried out between **Thursday 5th May and Sunday 8th May during standard hours** from **7am to 6pm**, and is expected to take **up to three days** to complete weather permitting.

Weekend work will take place in the rail corridor during scheduled Sydney Trains maintenance work, when trains are not running and the station is closed.

Work will include geotechnical investigations and an electrical condition survey.

Equipment to be used includes hand-held tools and hand auger, which is not expected to generate loud noise.
