Continued Saturday extended hours

Transport for NSW is upgrading Wollstonecraft Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Continued Saturday extended hours

Due to the recent wet weather, our extended work hours need to continue over the next two Saturdays, **16 April** and **23 April** from **7am to 6pm**.

On these days you will see the following activities continue or commence:

- line marking and signage installation,
- reinstatement of vegetation and the garden bed
- landscaping and paving
- correcting defects.

Any scheduled concrete pouring activities will require the use of specialised equipment such as an excavator, dump truck, compactor, concrete vibrator, jackhammer, and other powered hand tools to carry out these works.

For the safety of our workers, pedestrians, and motorists **the parking and mail zone slip lane on Shirley Road will be temporarily closed** during the work. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your patience as we carry out the final works to deliver this important accessibility upgrade.

As these works are weather dependant, they may need to be further extended. Should this occur, we will notify the community prior to any work commencing.
