

Wollstonecraft Station Upgrade

Saturday extended hours, temporary parking and mail zone closure

Transport for NSW is upgrading Wollstonecraft Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming Saturday extended hours

Work hours will be extended over the next three Saturdays, including 26 March, 2 and 9 April from 7am to 6pm. On these days you will see the following activities continue or commence:

- removal and reinstatement of the footpath, kerb, driveway, and refuge island on Shirley Road and Telopea Street
- installation of fencing along the new kerb
- removal and reinstatement of line marking for the accessible parking and kiss and ride area.

We will undertake concrete pouring activities and will require the use of equipment including an excavator, dump truck, compactor, concrete vibrator, jackhammer and other powered hand tools to carry out these works. For the safety of our workers, pedestrians and motorists **the parking and mail zone slip lane on Shirley Road will be temporarily closed** during the work.

Some diversions will be in place for customers accessing Platform 1. Please follow the temporary signs and traffic controller's directions.
