# Temporary closure of the M4 Roper Road westbound off ramp Wednesday 22 March

#### Transport for NSW | March 2023

The M4 Roper Road westbound on ramp is open to traffic. Over the next few months, the project will be carrying out work to complete the project. As part of this, we will temporarily close the M4 westbound off ramp at night to facilitate asphalt work. This will take place from 8pm Wednesday 22 March to 5am Thursday 23 March 2023, weather permitting. Should the work not take place on this this date we will do this work on the next available night shift.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank the community for their ongoing support during the project.

## **Traffic changes**

Traffic control and electronic signage will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users. To minimise traffic disruption, road users will be redirected to the M4 Mamre Road westbound off ramp (see map). Road users are encouraged to plan ahead for the detour that will be in place. Any changes to the date will be notified via electronic signage.

## Remaining work to be completed

From Saturday 1 April to Wednesday 31 May 2023, we plan to:

- commission the new electrical services, signage, safety features and smart motorway infrastructure
- complete landscaping and reinstate work areas
- finalise placement of linemarking, barriers and kerbing
- remove access tracks, site sheds and compound



#### Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are **Monday to Friday** from **7am to 6pm** and **Saturday** from **7am to 4pm**. We will not work on public holidays.

To complete the remaining activities, we may need to work at night between **8pm – 5am from Saturday 1 April to Wednesday 31 May 2023.** We will work up to five night shifts per week, weather permitting. Sunday day works may be required to account for potential weather-related delays.

# How will the work affect you?

Some of our activities may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise disruption by carrying out noisier work before midnight and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Equipment used may include road saw, vac truck, excavator, roller, trucks, profiler, light vehicles and lighting towers.
